Grammy-nominated Father of Folk Gordon Lightfoot To Perform at Temple Theatre

Saginaw, MI— Legendary singer-songwriter, Gordon Lightfoot, has been astounding packed audiences for over 40 years with his unique, artful blend of folk, country, and popular music. A distinct baritone voice and folk-based acoustic guitar style contribute to Lightfoot's timeless and unforgettable sound. As a multi-platinum troubadour, he is no stranger to the limelight, having recorded with artists like Bob Dylan and Elvis Presley.

With popular hits such as "Sundown," "Did She Mention My Name," and "If You Could Read My Mind," Lightfoot helped define the folk-pop sound of the 1960s and 1970s. Having released his 20th original album in 2004, Lightfoot continues to develop and enhance this ageless style of music, still impressing audiences young and old.

On Sunday, March 15, 2009, Gordon Lightfoot will grace the stage of Saginaw's own Temple Theatre, delighting audiences with his time-honored classics and authentic sound. The show begins at 7pm and tickets range from \$35 to \$45, with no additional fees when purchased at the Temple Theatre box office or by calling (877) 754-SHOW.
