“T” Tours at the Temple Theatre

SAGINAW, MI -- The beautiful Temple Theatre will be offering “T” Tours – Temple Theatre Tours, every Tuesday at 2 PM, and costs only \$2 per person. The tours are available throughout the summer, from June 7 through August 30. Each tour lasts approximately 1.5 hours, and reservations are not required.

Guests are taken back in time, where they will see the original colors and textures of the theatre from 1927. The gold leafing and hand painted details throughout the entire building add majesty and intrigue to the renowned *Showplace of Northeastern Michigan*. The tour will take visitors on the stage where Vaudeville acts and Photoplay (silent movie) were once accompanied by a ten-piece live orchestra. Along the excursion, patrons will get a special glimpse of the Butterfield Barton Pipe Organ, one of 12 in the world, which was built specifically for the theatre.

The tour also takes patrons through the adjacent three-story Shrine Clubhouse, which includes the swanky Leopard Lounge, the classy Premier Room, and the magnificent Grand Ballroom.
